Overview & scope

Science Advances (ISSN: 2375-2548) is the latest and fourth peer-reviewed journal to join the Science family. The online-only gold open access journal rapidly publishes high-quality original research in life, physical, environmental, mathematical, engineering, computer, and social sciences.

The *Science Advances* editorial office will receive manuscript submissions in September 2014. The journal's first papers will be published in February 2015.

The American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) is launching *Science Advances* because the organization receives more high-quality submissions than can be accommodated within the pages of *Science*, and its members and authors seek a high-quality open access venue for their research. The journal broadens the scope of the *Science* family and increases the number of outstanding papers AAAS can publish.

Editorial team, peer review, and publishing process

The journal will be edited by Marcia McNutt, Ph.D., editorin-chief of *Science*, as well as an interdisciplinary team of six academic deputy editors and 40 associate editors.

Submissions will undergo thorough peer review to ensure that those accepted for publication are scientifically sound and make important contributions to research in relevant disciplines.

Science Advances is a continuous publication journal. Papers will be published online shortly after acceptance. All articles will be professionally copyedited, proofread, and typeset.

Publishing licenses and article processing charges (APC)

Authors may choose to publish under one of two Creative Commons licenses: CC BY or CC BY-NC. The CC BY license allows authors to distribute, adapt, or re-use articles, including for commercial purposes.

The CC BY-NC license allows authors to distribute, adapt, or re-use articles for non-commercial purposes, while commercial re-use requires permission. The article processing charge for a CC BY-NC license is \$3,000.

Discounts will be available for corresponding authors who are AAAS members and/or whose affiliated institutions license or subscribe to *Science* journals:

- Maximum savings of \$900 on APC are available for authors whose affiliated institutions subscribe to the complete *Science* Collection (*Science, Science* Express, *Science* Classic, *Science Signaling*, and *Science Translational Medicine*).
- Authors at institutions that do not have the complete *Science* Collection will save \$150 for each e-resource currently in their institution's collection, with total savings up to \$600.

Surcharges will apply for authors:

- Selecting to publish using a CC BY license, \$1,000
- Whose papers are more than 15 pages in length, \$1,500

AAAS will offer waivers upon request to corresponding authors in the developing world or to those who face financial hardships.

A series of promotional discounts will also be available to *Science Advances'* first authors during the journal's launch, including an inaugural 45% discount.
